For the purpose of this procedure, the terms and definitions provided in *FSC-STD-01-002 FSC Glossary of terms*, *FSC-PRO-06-002 The Development and approval of FSC National Risk Assessments* and *FSC-STD-40-005 Requirements for Sourcing FSC Controlled Wood* apply.

## 1 Document flow

- 1.1 National risk assessments developed according to version 3-0 of *FSC-PRO-60-002* supersede national risk assessments developed according to version 2-0 of *FSC-PRO-60-002*.
- 1.2 National risk assessments approved according to the version 2-0 of *FSC-PRO-60-002* remain valid until 31 December 2018, subject to 1.1.

NOTE: National risk assessments approved according to version 2-0 of *FSC-PRO-60-002* are listed in Annex A of this procedure addendum.

- 1.3 Copies of national and Regional risk assessments are available from FSC on request and are published on the Global Forest Registry (<http://www.globalforestregistry.org>).
- 1.4 Risk designations included in approved risk assessments are transferred to the Global Forest Registry (<http://www.globalforestregistry.org>) upon approval.
